COMMITED TO THE GRAVE

Hemet, California was once known for gang activity and drug business. The gang activity was so widespread that it wasn't uncommon to see three generations of one family with membership in the most pervasive group, the First Street Gang. The violence was so rampant that even police officers wouldn't go into the area without back up. Nine methamphetamine labs supplied more than a million people a year. The dominant religion was Scientology and a meditation center stood as the centerpiece of the town, a symbol of the New Age fetish. A spirit of competition, particularly among the pastors, marked the Christian community. Known as a pastor's graveyard, Hemet was the last place most pastors wanted to be in ministry.

God called the Beckets to this valley, but they didn't want to be there. When they arrived, they didn't even unpack their bags, hoping God would let them leave. But they were soon assured this was God's calling on their lives. To show their commitment to God's Word, the Beckets bought a cemetery plot as a way of saying, "There's no way out. Unless God tells us differently, we will die here".

In the years since their commitment to God's leading and with the help of other area pastors, Hemet has completely changed. Cult membership has sunk to less than .003 percent of the population. First Street Gang members have gotten saved and disbanded the group. The drug trade has dropped by 75 percent. Even the New Age Meditation Center was demolished by a fire that didn't destroy anything else. Government officials, officers, and teachers have gotten saved. Hemet schools used to be the laughing stock of California and now have the highest scores and lowest dropout rates. Churches and pastors aren't competing anymore, they are coming together to build the kingdom of God. All because of an unrelenting commitment to obedience.

Groups will be adjusted to equal children out as needed. We no longer have a teen class but I will divide them to assist with groups as needed. They will still be able to participate in all the rotations.


Groups are not set in stone. Siblings and friends may stay together when needed but the attendance book needs to be informed for counts.

Crafts Bible Story Snack time

Deanna Lawson will instruct crafts. Crafts will have two items most days, one peel and stick and one to color. They will also decorate t-shirts to wear to the closing program.

Snacks will have a prepackaged choices with Kool-Aid and water options each day.



We will watch for food allergies and adjust snacks if needed. Please let leaders know if a child has food allergies.

Children will receive a Bible buddy character and watch a video about the Bible point of the day. Janice Pender will lead the Bible buddy lesson.

The Bible story lesson will be given by Jane Lee and assistants. She will instruct the daily Bible story adjusted to the age of the group but adults will be blessed by her lesson also!

Everyone gathers back into the sanctuary for the closing program. We will sing and watch a kid's video about the daily lesson and dismiss VBS from the sanctuary. Parents and adults are always welcome to stay and rotate with children! Please remember to respect the children and not disrupt with socialization during or at stations.



GROUP LEADERS WILL BE NEEDED FOR THE THREE GROUPS.

Three volunteers are needed every night to guide children to stations and closing program. It is best to have one contact person for each group.

Group leaders have the role of loving on the children! Show them God's LOVE and demonstrate Godly attitudes! Are you up for the task?

You have been guided by Jesus and the Holy Spirit! Your wholehearted participation in every activity will say so much to them.
